We hold everyone, including ourselves, our guests, our employees and our spectators to the following standards:

- Exhibiting fairness and integrity and not engaging in any behaviour that could
 - Be considered harassment or discrimination (see links below for definitions)
 - Endanger themselves or any other person
 - Cause damage to the equipment or facilities
- Following pickleball safety and etiquette guidelines on and off the court (posted on the Club's website), including not playing under the influence of alcohol or recreational drugs
